Bottles

Frome Valley (Dry and Medium) 6% 50cl £3.95

Pleasant bittersweet apple flavour, well-balanced sweetness and acidity, not too astringent and without excessive bitter aftertaste associated with some traditional ciders.

Gwatkin Kingston Black (dry, single variety) 7.5% 50cl £3.95

The Kingston Black apple is the most famous apple in the cider making world. Dating back centuries, the variety originated in Somerset, but by the 1800s it had spread all over England & Wales. A favourite with the old farming communities and their traditional way of cider making; often kept for the vintage house cider and drunk on special occasions. There have been various new strains of this variety grown but none to match the taste of the old. Matured in oak barrels with natural yeasts.

Dunkertons Black Fox (organic single variety) 7% 50cl £3.95

This is a lovely bright and rather special medium dry cider made from 9 varieties of traditional cider apple including Eggleton Styre. This variety adds characteristic dry complexity to a highly successful cider. Black Fox is named after the mythical animal which mysteriously eludes all attempts to catch it. One of its favourite haunts is said to be the cider orchard where the heavily laden branches deter the hunt from entering. The fox is believed to bestow good fortune on the orchard with an abundant crop!

Gwatkin Yarlington Mill (medium, single variety) 7.5% 50cl £3.95

Gold Winner 09 'Smooth and rich with a spirit aroma and taste that resonates with the taste buds to surprise and delight. Would be an excellent substitute for a dessert wine.'

Dunkertons Sparkling Perry (organic) 7.5% 50cl £4.20

A delicious English drink which keeps slipping tantalisingly from our grip due to a shortage of organic perry pears. Stocks now seem more stable and so we're delighted to relaunch HMS Perry. Made in the same way as cider, but from pears rather than apples, it's aromatic, delicate, gently fruity and very refreshing. Though relatively uncommon, the perry pear trees are easily identified in Herefordshire's orchard landscape by their great height and cascading white blossom - the varieties used here include Merrylegs, Red Horse, Moorcoft, Painted Lady and Thorn.

Thatchers Katy (single variety) 7.4% 50cl £3.95

Light, dry, fragrant and softly sparkling. Great to enjoy on its own and with chicken, rice or pasta.

Thatchers Cox (single variety) 5.3% 50cl £3.95

A single variety cider made purely from one apple type capturing the distinctive natural qualities of Cox's apples. Naturally sweet and juicy

Thatchers Oak Matured 5.2% 50cl £3.95

For centuries traditional cider has been matured in oak barrels, but barrels previously used for rum impart a distinct touch of demerara to the cider as it matures. Smooth flavour and subtle aroma

Thatchers Pear Cider 4.5% 50cl £3.95

Made using traditional techniques and expertise gained over 100 years, the fruit is carefully pressed and the cider patiently matured in oak vats by thatchers master cider maker.

Thatchers Old Rascal 4.5% 50cl (medium dry) £3.95

Legend has it that every night, under the cover of darkness, a wily old fox crept out of his den at the bottom of Thatchers orchard, and tiptoed his way to the cider store to help himself to fresh supplies.

Thatchers Scrumy Jug 6% 2.5ltr £11.50

Drawn straight from the barrel.

Single Malt

All served in the larger 35ml measures...

Laphroaig 10yr 40% (Islay) £3.40

A massive whisky from Laphroaig Distillery. Smoke and peat in total control.

Lagavulin 16yr 43% (Islay) £3.90

By many the best Islay malt. Smoke, Peat and fruity notes.

Cragganmore 12yr 40% (Speyside) £3.05

A relative unknown malt whisky from Speyside. Medium to full-bodied. Fruity and malty. Good all rounder.

Glenmorangie 10yr 40% (Highlands) £3.20

A classic distillery in the northern parts of the Highlands. The number one top seller in Scotland. A characteristic malt from the region which is highly appreciated amongst connoisseurs. Only matured in bourbon casks. Medium, slight oiliness with notes of fruit and vanilla.

Oban 14yr 43% (Highlands) £3.85

It is considered to be in the middle range regarding richness and complexity. Not as powerful as Islay whiskies and not as mild as lowland whiskies. Full-bodied, malty, spicy, slightly smoky.

Talisker 10yr 45.8% (Islands) £3.30

Talisker Distillery is known primarily for its 10 year-old single malt and is currently the only distillery on the Isle of Skye. Full bodied. Powerful smoke and malt. Salty.

Dalwhinnie 15yr 43% (Highlands) £3.40

The colour is yellow gold. The nose, spicy, "grassy" and slightly smoked evokes the wax and honey but remains close to barley. The sweet palate confirms the nose. The milky finish is a bit bitter, and has some liquorice, smoked barley, lemon grass and anise hints,

Isle of Jura 10yr 40% (Island) £2.70

Sweetish, soft, malty, oily, slowly developing a slight island dryness and saltiness. A lovely aperitif.

Glenkinchie 10yr 43% (Lowland) £3.05

The colour is yellow, the nose sweet, full and well balanced has some lemon, herbal and malty hints. The palate is sugared and marked by the malt (porridge) and yeast (beer) with a touch of peat. The finish, of average length confirms this impressions. A pleasant, but simple whisky.

Coal ILA 12yr 43% (Islay) £3.90

For lovers of Ardbeg, Laphroaig, and Lagavulin, this Islay distillery is less famous but very highly rated. Sweet, smoky and lip-smackingly good!

Tomatin 12yr 40% (Highland) £3.30

A delicate aroma, light & smooth with a hint of peach

Glenfarclas 10yr 40% (Highland) £3.50

Crisp and dry at first, flavours developing with a sweet long finish

Ardmore 16yr 43% (Speyside) £3.95

Big in character with hints of marzipan, sherry and a nutty oily body. Dry finish

Cognac

Courvoisier V.S £2.80

A fruity, delicate taste with a bouquet suffused with ripe fruit and spring flowers. The aroma is rich, fresh and oaky balanced with the vigour of a young cognac. The finish is short but very intense and as powerful as the aroma.

Remy Martin V.S.O.P £3.35

A fine smooth Cognac with rich plummy fruit flavours and aromas and a good dose of oak at the finish.

Courvoisier X.O imperial £6.50

Courvoisier XO Imperial is intensely aromatic and flavourful with a velvet texture and redolent bouquet with hints of orange, apricot and pear. It is very rich and complex with aromas of chocolate, vanilla and amber, and the old Borderies add exotic and bakery spices. The finish is very long and mellow with great depth and long development.
